System Expansion Project

Project description

As a result of increasing demand for natural gas in the area, Enbridge Gas North Carolina is expanding its system by installing a natural gas pipeline from Enochville to Concord. Once in-service, the pipeline will provide the additional natural gas supply and system flexibility needed to deliver safe and reliable service to homes and businesses as this area continues to grow. To minimize impacts to the community and environment, the pipeline will be built along predominantly existing right of way.

Q: Will work impact traffic?

As construction will occur mainly on road shoulders, there will be some traffic disruptions on several sections along the route. Traffic control specialists and devices will be present to help motorists travel safely in the areas impacted.
